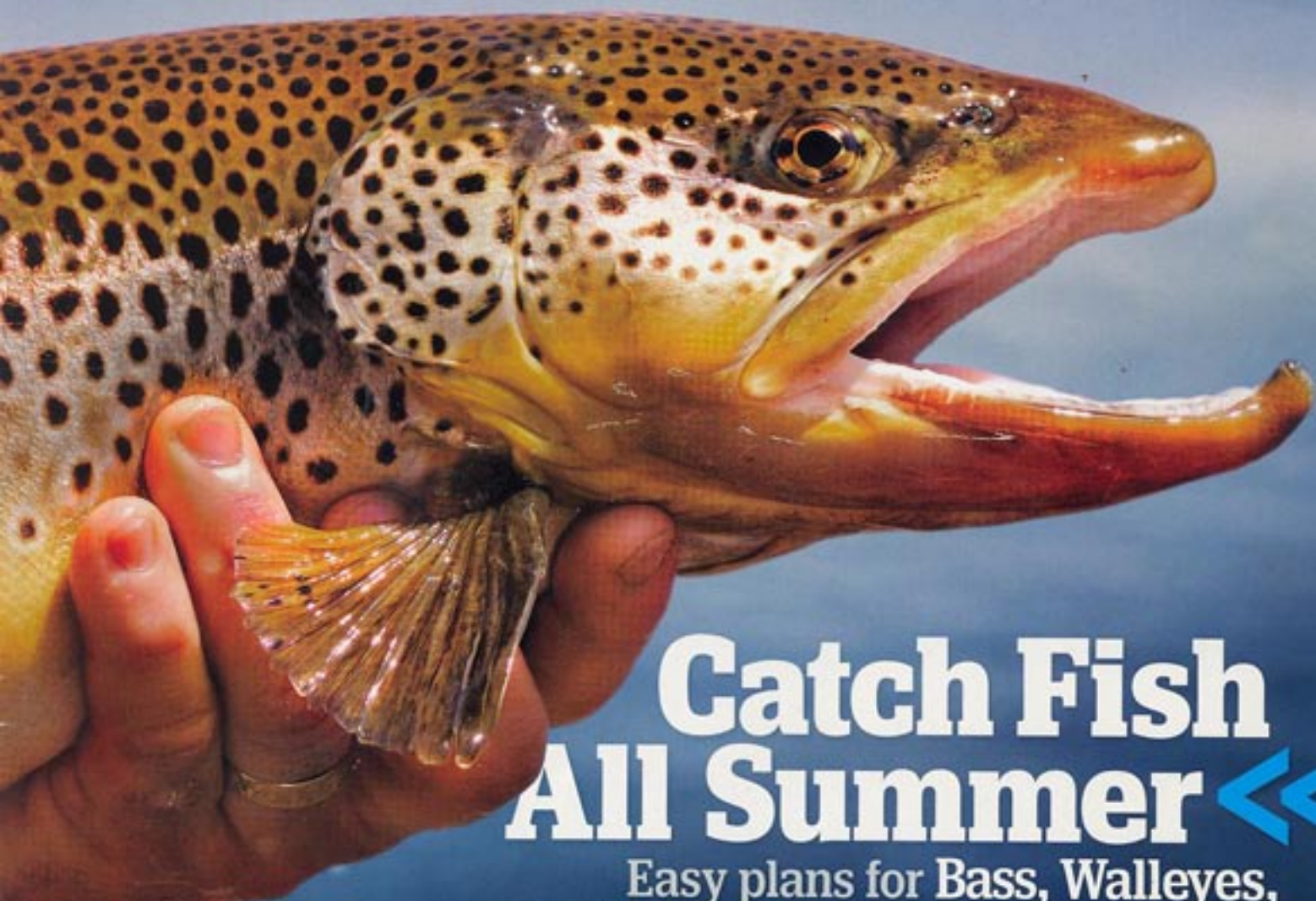

### JACKED UP

"Hooking an amberjack is like catching a car on a freeway 400 feet down," says Jon Schwartz, holding a 40-pounder off the Hawaiian coast last July. Schwartz pursues everything from marlin to tuna to tiger sharks from a kayak (this one is only 12½ feet long), using custom rods and 80-pound-test braided lines. "In a 'yak, it's just you and the fish. It's primordial. And I want the biggest monsters possible."
